Visitors can view old town and tax records, railroad memorabilia, genealogical records, archaeological artifacts, photographs, books, a complete cemetery listing from 1795, old newspapers and clippings, maps dating back to the 1800s, old postcards, tools of yesteryear and hundreds of other artifacts. Preservation and conservation of these items are an integral part of the society's goals.
