Laurie McBurnie has completed a fully-illustrated book about all 85 of the cemeteries in Nobleboro -- and it is outstanding.

The Cemeteries of Nobleboro, Maine is a collection of articles originally published in *The Lincoln County News* as a feature column highlighting each of the cemeteries. Laurie has visited each of the cemeteries many, many times and the descriptions of the cemeteries include the names and genealogy of those buried there, often with some historical and/or anecdotal background, as well as full-color photos.

To ensure that the book is user-friendly, there is an extensive index of those buried in these cemeteries. The index includes first name, surname, maiden name, cemetery buried in, dates of birth and death, age at death, spouse(s), parents and veteran status. All cemeteries are cross-referenced by cemetery name and number. A chapter on cleaning and caring for headstones is also included since many individuals attempt to clean headstones and use methods that can damage the stone.

This 284-page book has a wire binding, so it will lie flat for easy use. It is published by Lincoln County Publishing with printing paid for by the Nobleboro Historical Society.
