Each spring, the Nobleboro Historical Society selects awardees for their Society scholarships. Each scholarship is for \$1,500. This application form is for **both** *high school students* and for *students already attending post-secondary school*.

Eligible high school and post-secondary students are those who will attend an accredited undergraduate post-secondary school or college in the 2026-2027 academic year and who reside in the Town of Nobleboro. Also, students who are members or children of members of the Society are eligible. The required essay should make a case as to why the applicant should receive a scholarship.
